EDUCATION and HONORS

Dr. Jack B. Share earned his undergraduate degree in Biology at Syracuse University in 1970. He then studied at the State University of New York at Buffalo School of Dentistry receiving the Doctor of Dental Surgery degree in 1974. Graduating with high honors, he was elected to membership in the prestigious Omicron Kappa Upsilon National Dental Honor Society for his "academic achievements, scholarship and character in dentistry." After graduation, Doctor Share completed a General Practice Residency at the Upstate Medical Center in Syracuse, New York, which focused on prosthetics, oral surgery and general anesthesia.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES and PUBLICATIONS

Shortly afterward, Dr. Share relocated to Boston and accepted an appointment on the faculty at the Tufts University School of Dental Medicine as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Restorative Dentistry. His activities included lecturing within the school, as well as locally and nationally, and conducting research. Dr. Share has authored numerous professional journal articles on bonding, restorative dentistry, anatomy and local anesthesia, and has presented his findings to the National Association of Dental Research. In addition the doctor contributed a chapter to a textbook on bonding and cosmetic dentistry.

Dr. Share entered private practice in the Financial District of Boston in 1983, where he remains to this day.
